YEAR 11 MOCK GCSE EXAMINATION TIMETABLE DECEMBER 2009

- Overleaf is your timetable for your mock examinations. Please check it carefully and make sure that you know when your particular examinations are.
- In the sessions when you **do not have an examination go to your normal lesson.**
- All the exams will take place in the **SPORTS HALL** unless stated otherwise.
- **Seating plans** for all examinations will be displayed on the **examinations noticeboard** outside Ma5. Check them very carefully. If your name does not appear in a subject you are doing see Mr Short immediately.
- Unless you are told otherwise, start times for **ALL** examinations are:

Morning	-	8.45
Mid-morning	-	11.00
Afternoon	-	1.45

- Make sure you are at the appropriate place **at least 10 mins before** the scheduled start time and that **you know where you should be sitting.**
- Make sure you have all the equipment you need before arriving at your seat. This should include as a minimum: pens (more than 1), pencil, ruler and rubber. It may also include specialist equipment eg. calculator, protractor, compasses, felt pens, stencils etc.
- Do **NOT** leave your coats, bags etc in the PE changing rooms. Use the cloakrooms for this purpose but make sure that you do not leave any money or valuables unattended. If necessary, give valuable items to a teacher in the examination.
- **There will be no equipment of ANY kind available to borrow in the Sports Hall.**

This will be your only chance to experience an examination period like this before your GCSE examinations in May/June. Please use this experience sensibly. If you have any questions see Mr Short.
